Purpose of the register

The purpose of processing personal data is to manage customer relationships and communication. Personal data is used for company communication, marketing, and sales.

Basis for data collection and processing

The customer's data is collected and processed with the customer's consent or for the performance of a contract with the customer.

Data content of the register

The following data is processed in the register:

- contact information, such as name, email address and phone number
- information on the marketing content used by the data subject, such as message opening and click data

Data retention period

Personal data will be stored for as long as it is necessary to fulfil the purpose for which it was collected in accordance with this privacy policy.

Regular sources of information

Personal data is collected from the data subjects themselves and from public sources, such as internet, companies' public websites, online social networks, or other corresponding registers in accordance with data protection legislation. Data is also collected using the Google Analytics tool.

Regular disclosure of data and transfer of data outside the EU or the European economic area

Data is not regularly disclosed outside the company.



Use of cookies

On our website, we use cookies that is a small text file sent to and stored on the user's computer, which enables the website administrator to identify frequent visitors, make it easier for visitors to log in to the site and enable compiling aggregate information about visitors. This feedback allows us to continuously improve the content of our website. Cookies do not harm users' computers or files. Cookies are used so that we can provide our customers with information and services based on their individual needs.

If a user visiting our website does not want us to receive the above-mentioned information through cookies, most browsers allow you to disable the cookie function. This is usually done through the browser settings.

However, it is good to note that cookies may be necessary for the proper functioning of the website and the services we offer.

Protection of the register

The server of the website is SSL secured.

Electronic data is protected by a firewall, usernames, and passwords.

Access to the data is only granted to those persons employed by the controller who need the data in their duties.

Automated decision-making

Automated individual decisions (Article 22 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation) are not made.

Rights of the data subject

The data subject has the right to check what information about him or her has been stored in the personal data register. A signed written inspection request must be sent to the person responsible for register.

The right of inspection is free of charge no more than once a year.

The data subject has the right to demand the correction or deletion of incorrect or outdated data or the transfer of data from one system to another. They also have the right to restrict or object to the processing of their data in accordance with Articles 18 and 21 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation.

The data subject has the right to withdraw his or her previously given consent to the processing of data or to complain about the matters related to the processing of his or her personal data to a supervisory authority.

The data subject also has the right to prohibit the use of their data for direct marketing purposes.
